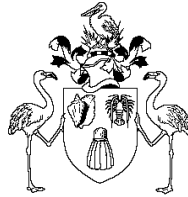

TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDER STATUS ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDER STATUS;
ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDER STATUS COMMISSION; AND
FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES.

Commencement

[1 April 2016]

PART I

PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Turks and Caicos Islander Status Ordinance.

Interpretation

2. In this Ordinance—

“British Overseas Territories Citizen” means a person who is a British Overseas Territories Citizen under the British Nationality Act 1981 by virtue of a connection with the Islands;

“child” means a person who has not attained the age of eighteen years and who is the child or adopted child of any person; and the fact that a person’s parents are not or have not been married to one another shall be left out of account in establishing whether the person is the child of those parents; and accordingly that person shall be treated as if those parents are or have been married to one another;

“Commission” means the Turks and Caicos Islander Status Commission established under section 12;

“dependant”, except in the expression “dependant child” or “dependant children”, means, in relation to a person, his spouse and dependant children;

“Islander”, means a person who has acquired Turks and Caicos Islander status as mentioned in section 3 or 4; and “Islander status” shall be construed accordingly;

“Islander Status Card” means a National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card issued under section 8;

“Islander Status Certificate” means a Turks and Caicos Islander Status Certificate issued under section 7;

“member” means a member of the Commission;

“Minister” means the Minister responsible for immigration;

“Permanent Residence Certificate” means a certificate granted under the Immigration Ordinance;

“Secretary” means the Secretary of the Commission appointed under section 18;

“settled in the Islands” shall be construed in accordance with section 3(3).

PART II

TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDER STATUS

Islander status: acquisition as of right

3. (1) A person who has Turks and Caicos Islander status (Islander status) immediately before the commencement of this section, has that status for the purposes of this Ordinance.

(2) A person (P) acquires Islander status if any of the following applies—

(a) P is born in the Islands and at the time of P’s birth at least one of P’s parents has Islander status;

(b) P is born outside the Islands and, at the time of P’s birth—

(i) at least one of P’s parents has Islander status; and

(ii) at least one of P’s parents or grandparents was born in the Islands;

(c) P is born outside the Islands and at the time of P’s birth at least one of P’s parents—

(i) has Islander status; and

(ii) was settled in the Islands; or

(d) P is adopted in the Islands by a person who has Islander status at the time of the adoption, and P has not attained the age of eighteen years at the time of the adoption.

(3) For the purposes of subsection (2)(c), a person is settled in the Islands if—

(a) subsection (4) applies;

(b) he is not subject to any immigration restriction or control on the duration of his stay in the Islands; and

(c) he has not voluntarily emigrated with the intention of making his home elsewhere.

(4) This subsection applies to a person who has uninterrupted voluntary physical presence in the Islands for a period of time without legal impediment (other than as a tourist visitor or transit passenger) during which period the Islands are regarded as his normal place of abode for the time being.

(5) For the purposes of subsection (4)—

(a) absence abroad for purposes such as education and health are to be treated as included in the period mentioned in that subsection;

(b) absence abroad for a period not exceeding six consecutive months for purposes such as vacation or business are to be treated as included in the period mentioned in that subsection;

(c) absence abroad for a period exceeding six consecutive months but not exceeding twelve consecutive months creates a presumption that the period mentioned in that subsection has been interrupted;

(d) absence abroad for a period exceeding twelve consecutive months interrupts the period mentioned in that subsection;

(e) a person is a tourist visitor if he enters the Islands for a period not exceeding six months other than—

(i) for professional, financial trade or business purposes; or

(ii) for the purpose of seeking or engaging in employment; and

(f) a person is a transit passenger if—

(i) he has entered the Islands for a period not exceeding twenty-four hours;

(ii) he is in possession of the required travel documents; and

(iii) he is on his way to a destination other than the country from which he arrived.

(6) This section does not affect a person who has acquired Islander status before the commencement of this Ordinance.

Islander status: acquisition by grant

4. (1) The Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commission grant Islander status to a person to whom any of subsections (2) to (6) apply.

(2) This subsection applies to a person if he is a British overseas territories citizen by virtue of a connection with the Islands or a British Citizen who either—

(a) has held a permanent residence certificate for a period of at least five years; or

(b) has been legally resident in the Islands for a period of at least ten years; and

- (c) is neither serving a sentence imposed by a court for an offence against the law in force in any country, nor has been adjudged or otherwise declared bankrupt under any law in force in any country and has not been discharged.
- (3) This subsection applies to a person if—
- (a) the person's spouse has Islander status otherwise than by virtue of marriage; and
 - (b) the Governor is satisfied that the person—
 - (i) has lived together with the spouse for a period of ten years ending with the date of the application; and
 - (ii) has been resident in the Islands for a period of two years ending with that date.
- (4) This subsection applies to a person if he is the dependant child of a person who is accorded Islander status by virtue of subsection (3).
- (5) This subsection applies to a person who—
- (a) is born in the Islands to parents who at the time of his birth were legally resident in the Islands;
 - (b) has acquired British Overseas Territories Citizenship by virtue of section 15(4) of the British Nationality Act 1981;
 - (c) has been legally resident in the Islands for a period of at least ten years; and
 - (d) has attained the age of eighteen years.
- (6) This subsection applies if—
- (a) the person is married to a person who has been granted Islander status by virtue of residency, and that person was endorsed on the Residence Permit as the spouse;
 - (b) the person is under the age of eighteen years, and was endorsed on a Permanent Residence Certificate; or
 - (c) the person is the child of a person who is the spouse of an Islander, who has not been adopted by the spouse who is an Islander or who is not the biological child of the Islander, who was endorsed in that person's Residence Permit.
- (7) In considering an application from a person to whom subsection (2) applies, the Governor shall have regard to the following matters—
- (a) whether it is in the public interest to grant the Islander status;
 - (b) whether the applicant—
 - (i) is of good character and conduct;
 - (ii) has to his credit three good character references received by the Governor directly from three Islanders; and

- (iii) has a clean criminal record;
- (c) whether the applicant suffers from any form of communicable or mental disease that would make him a danger to the community;
- (d) whether the applicant has been involved in organising or engaging in any subversive political activity, or has organised, caused or promoted racism or any illegal activity within the Islands;
- (e) whether the economic situation of the Islands and the protection of persons already engaged in similar gainful occupations have been duly considered;
- (f) the desirability of granting the right to be an Islander to applicants with different backgrounds and from different geographical areas so that a suitable balance in the social and economic life of the Islands may be maintained;
- (g) whether the applicant brings any exceptional skill to the Islands;
- (h) the desirability of retaining the economic resources of the Islands in the control of Islanders; and
- (i) whether the applicant meets any prescribed evaluation criteria.

(8) Subsection (7) does not apply if the applicant is the child, stepchild or parent of an Islander.

(9) In subsection (7)(i), prescribed evaluation criteria are any guidelines issued by the Governor, for the purpose of evaluating the merits of an application by awarding to or discounting from the applicant, credits based on his personal and occupational attributes as well as his potential value to the community.

Application for Turks and Caicos Islander Status

5. (1) An application for the grant of Islander status may be made by or on behalf of an applicant to the Governor—

- (a) in respect of a spouse of an Islander, in Form 1 set out in Schedule 1; and
- (b) in respect of any other person, in Form 2 set out in Schedule 1.

(2) An application made under subsection (1)(b), which is an application for the grant of Islander status other than by marriage, shall be submitted to the Secretary of the Commission.

(3) An application for the grant of Islander status, except an application for grant by marriage, shall be made between 1 June and 30 September of every year.

Publication

6. (1) Upon receipt of an application made under section 5(1)(b), the Secretary shall cause a notice of the application to be published in at least two issues of a local newspaper circulating in the Islands, which publication shall include—

- (a) the fact of application;
- (b) a photograph of the applicant;
- (c) the name of the island on which he resides;
- (d) the name of spouse if any, and number of dependants; and
- (e) any other particulars as may be prescribed.

(2) A publication made under subsection (1) shall request submissions to be made to the Secretary within thirty days of the last publication, and no application shall be considered by the Commission unless it has been published.

(3) When the Commission makes a recommendation to the Governor, of persons to be granted Islander status, the Secretary shall cause a notice of the list of names to be published in at least one issue of a local newspaper circulating in the Islands.

(4) The Governor shall not grant Islander status unless he first caused a notice of his intention to do so in relation to the applicant, to be published in at least two issues of a local newspaper circulating in the Islands.

(5) The notice published pursuant to subsection (4) shall include a photograph of the applicant and request any submissions to be made not later than thirty days after the date of the last publication.

Islander Status certificate

7. (1) The Governor shall cause to be issued, a Turks and Caicos Islander Status Certificate, as the Governor shall determine, to any person who is accorded Islander status under section 4.

(2) A Turks and Caicos Islander Status Certificate issued under subsection (1) shall be in Form 3 set out in Schedule 1.

(3) A Turks and Caicos Islander Status Certificate is evidence that a person has been granted Islander status.

Islander Status card

8. (1) The Governor shall cause to be issued, a National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card to any Islander who makes an application for the issue of such a card.

(2) An application for the issue of a National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card may be made by or on behalf of an applicant to the Governor in Form 4 set out in Schedule 1.

(3) The Governor may cause to be issued, a National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card in Form 5 set out in Schedule 1.

(4) A National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card is evidence that the person named in it is an Islander.

Fees

9. An application made under section 5 or 8 shall be accompanied by a fee specified in Schedule 2.

Revocation of Islander status

10. (1) Subject to subsection (3), this section applies where a person has been granted Islander status otherwise than by virtue of being the spouse of another person.

(2) The Governor may revoke an Islander status (with the effect that the person is no longer an Islander) if subsection (3) or (4) applies.

(3) This subsection applies if the application for the grant—

- (a) was false in a material particular; or
- (b) failed to disclose a material fact.

(4) This subsection applies if the person to whom Islander status was granted—

- (a) has been convicted of a criminal offence in any country and sentenced to a term of imprisonment of not less than twelve months; or
- (b) has not been resident in the Islands during the period of three years ending with the date of the revocation; and
- (c) has been resident in the Islands for less than fourteen years in total.

(5) Before revoking an Islander status the Governor shall, by notice in writing, inform the holder of the grounds on which it is proposed to revoke it and shall give the holder the opportunity to make representations.

(6) A notice given under subsection (5) shall state that, within sixty days of service of the notice, the person to whom the notice is addressed may make representations in writing to the Governor concerning the matter, and the Governor shall not determine the matter without considering any representations received within that period of sixty days.

(7) A person aggrieved by a decision of the Governor to revoke an Islander status under this section may appeal against that decision to the Supreme Court.

(8) Provisions may be made by rules of court with respect to the procedure to be followed on appeals to the Supreme Court pursuant to subsection (7).

(9) A reference to a person who has been granted “Islander status” includes a reference to a person who was granted Belonger status (within the meaning of the Immigration Ordinance Cap.5.01 of the Revision of the Laws dated 31 August 2009 as amended) before the commencement of this Ordinance.

Burden of proof of Islander status

11. In any question under this Ordinance whether a person is an Islander or is entitled to an exemption under this Ordinance, it shall lie on the person asserting it to prove that he is an Islander.

PART III

TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDER STATUS COMMISSION

Establishment of Turks and Caicos Islander Status Commission

12. For the purposes of this Ordinance there is established a Commission to be called the Turks and Caicos Islander Status Commission.

Functions of Commission

13. (1) The Commission shall—

- (a) after 1 January of each year, review applications for the grant of Islander status made under section 5(3);
- (b) make recommendations to the Governor for the grant of Islander status, which recommendation shall be made in writing not later than 31 October of each year; and
- (c) make recommendations for revocation of Islander status to the Governor on the grounds provided under section 10(3) and (4).

(2) For the purposes of the exercise of its functions, the Commission shall provide the Governor with such reports and other information as he may require.

Constitution of Commission

14. The Commission shall consist of the following members appointed by the Governor—

- (a) a Chairman;
- (b) four other members—
 - (i) two of whom shall be nominated for appointment by the Premier; and
 - (ii) two of whom shall be nominated for appointment by the Leader of the Opposition; and
- (c) the Attorney General or his representative, who shall be an *ex-officio* member.

Disqualification from appointment

15. A person is disqualified from appointment as a member—

- (a) if he is not an Islander; and

- (b) if his name is not on the current Register of Electors in force in the Islands.

Tenure

16. A member—

- (a) unless he sooner resigns or is removed from office, shall be appointed for a term of one year; and
- (b) shall not be eligible for re-appointment to the Commission until two years has passed since the expiry or termination of his last appointment to the Commission.

Termination of appointment

17. (1) The Governor may at any time terminate the appointment of an appointed member for inability to discharge the functions of his office (whether arising from infirmity of body or mind or any other cause) or for misbehaviour.

(2) An appointed member may at any time resign by giving notice in writing to the Governor, and his membership shall cease from the date the Governor receives the notice of resignation.

Meetings of Commission

18. (1) The Commission shall meet as often as is necessary or expedient for the discharge of its functions, and such meetings shall be held at such place, day and time as the Chairman may determine.

(2) The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Commission.

(3) Three members shall form a quorum at any meetings of the Commission.

(4) At a meeting of the Commission all questions shall be decided by a majority of the votes of the members present and voting, and in the event of an equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

(5) The Attorney General or his representative shall attend all meetings of the Commission, but shall have no right to vote.

(6) Subject to this Ordinance, the Commission may make rules to regulate its proceedings.

Secretary of Commission

19. (1) The Governor acting on the advice of the Minister shall appoint any public officer to be the Secretary of the Commission.

(2) The Secretary shall—

- (a) attend all meetings of the Commission but shall not vote on any matter or question before the Commission;
- (b) prepare minutes of the meetings of the Commission;

- (c) keep a record of the proceedings and decisions of the Commission;
- (d) receive applications for the grant of Islander status and review whether they are in order before submitting to the Commission for review;
- (e) cause publication of notices of applications received; and
- (f) attend to such other duties as the Chairman of the Commission may require.

(3) As soon as is practicable after every meeting of the Commission the Secretary shall furnish the Chairman, Minister and Governor with a copy of the minutes of meetings and proceedings of the Commission.

Preservation of confidentiality of information obtained by Commission

20. (1) A member of the Commission or a person who is lawfully connected with any business of the Commission shall regard and deal with any information relating to the business of any other person which he has obtained by virtue of such membership or connection as secret.

(2) A person referred to in subsection (1) shall not disclose or allow to be disclosed any information referred to in subsection (1) to anyone not lawfully entitled to the information.

(3) A person who without reasonable excuse discloses or allows to be disclosed information contrary to this section commits an offence and is liable—

- (a) on summary conviction to a fine of \$10,000 or a term of imprisonment of two years, or to both; and
- (b) if the offence is a continuing one, to a further fine of \$100 for every day or part of a day on which the offence has continued.

Remuneration

21. A member who is not a public officer shall be paid such remuneration as the Governor may determine.

Financial provisions

22. Any expenses of the Commission incurred in the performance of its functions under this Ordinance, shall be payable out of money appropriated by the House of Assembly for the purpose.

PART IV

GENERAL

Making false statements, furnishing false information

23. (1) A person commits an offence if, he knowingly makes a false or misleading statement or knowingly furnishes false or misleading information in connection with an application for—

(a) Islander status; and

(b) a National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card.

(2) A person commits an offence if—

(a) without lawful authority, he alters any certificate or card issued under this Ordinance; or

(b) he uses for the purpose of this Ordinance or has in his possession for such use, a forged, altered or irregular certificate or card.

(3) A person who commits an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$20,000 or a term of imprisonment of four years, or to both.

Evidence by certificate

24. In any proceedings for an offence under this Ordinance—

(a) a certificate signed by or on behalf of the Governor stating that, on any date, a person was or was not the holder of a Turks and Caicos Islander Status Certificate or National Turks and Caicos Islander Status Card shall be evidence of the facts stated; and

(b) a certificate stating that any of the matters mentioned and purporting to be signed by or on behalf of the Governor, shall be presumed to be so signed unless the contrary is proved.

Amendment of Schedule

25. The Governor may by Order published in the *Gazette*, amend a Schedule.

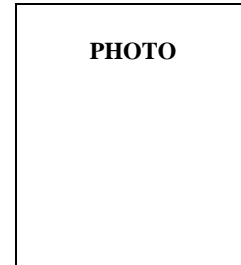

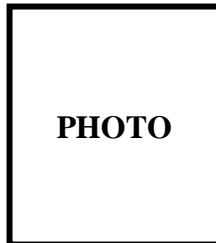
